

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

BARSTOOL

IMPORTANT INFORMATION - MUST READ BEFORE ASSEMBLY:

Every item is handmade and although effort has been taken to ensure your item reaches you in perfect condition, sometimes damage can be caused during transit. Please check the item before assembling and notify your retailer within 48 hours of taking delivery of any damages / defects, the retailer may request images and must include batch code label found underneath the chair seat.

No returns will be accepted after the item has been assembled, packaging has been discarded or goods signed for as received in good condition. This does not affect your statutory rights.

If your item has been finished in French Velvet please take a moment to read the following information:

It is impossible to prevent pressure marks in velvet. However, these quickly disappear when unpacked and left to breathe. With careful handling and a proper understanding of its nature, products made from velvet can be enjoyed for many years. If the pile does become crushed, the angle of the pile alters, which may result in areas of the pile appearing lighter or darker in shade. This is often described as pressure marking, which can easily be mistaken for uneven dyeing or manufactures fault. Newly made velvet products usually need time to condition in the atmosphere after unpacking. During this time the pile will relax and lift, improving the richness and the lustre of the velvet. If any pressure marking continues to persist, a light steaming or gentle brushing in the direction of the pile will also be beneficial.

Pile direction – there is no hard and fast rule about this but here are some things to help you decide which you prefer:

Pile up (if you brush your hand upwards and the pile feels smooth, but if you brush your hand down, it feels harsher and the pile is disturbed) gives the colour a richer and deeper appearance and any pile disturbance will disappear more quickly as the pile relaxes and blooms. Pile down (the opposite to above) allows more light to be reflected from the velvet, so the shade will stay lighter and the pile will stay quite flat, with more of a sheen, and any pile disturbance will show more readily and take longer to fall out.

SAFETY NOTICE - MUST READ BEFORE USING:

Falls from tipping furniture are some of the most common causes of injuries to adults, babies and children. Every effort has been taken to ensure the safety and stability of this product. However care must be taken at all times to prevent the barstool from tipping due to playing, climbing or rocking which can lead to falls resulting in minor, severe and possibly fatal injuries. This item is not recommended for use by children younger than 10 years old, any children using the item must be supervised by an adult at all times and must never be left unattended. When item is not used we recommend it is stored away and out of reach of children to avoid any

accidents.

The knocker is for decorative purpose only and must never be used to pull the chair.

This item is designed for use as barstool only. Cannot be used for any other purpose except for its intended use. The user must ensure there own safety by carefully sitting and getting off the barstool whilst elevated at its lowest point. Designed for domestic use only, commercial use will automatically void warranty.
